Fire Prevention and Life Safety Inspection

Purpose:

The purpose of our Annual Fire Prevention and Life Safety inspection program is to provide a safe place for our residents, those that work in our community, patrons of our commerce, manufacturing, and corporate industries, and our First Responders.

Policy:

The Department of Emergency Management and Services is responsible for conducting an annual Fire Prevention and Life Safety inspection in all businesses, facilities, places of assembly, and schools.

Method:

The Department designs an inspection schedule according to hazard priorities, develops an inspection checklist, and collects and distributes data that will be useful to our first responders. The Township hires a 3rd party agency that is assigned to this department to conduct these inspections. The inspectors are trained and fully certified to inspect for all fire prevention and life safety features in a facility. The inspectors will also identify any special operational uses that will require additional review and data to be conveyed to our first responders.

At the completion of each inspection, our department will send the inspected facility a letter of compliance, invoice, and an operational permit (if applicable).

Fees:

A fee schedule is adopted by the Board of Supervisors. This department follows the adopted fee schedule and invoices accordingly.
