Warminster Library is pleased to announce our new Museums and Parks Pass Program! With a library card in good standing, families can check out passes to local museums and attractions for no charge! Sites include the Academy of Natural Sciences, the Elwood Park Zoo, the Morris Arboretum, Bucks County Children’s Museum, Pearl S. Buck International, Penn Museum, the Battleship New Jersey, and the Glencairn Museum. Passes may only be reserved day-of, in person or by phone, and may be checked out for three days, including day of checkout. At the minimum, passes are good for up to two adults and at least three children; certain destinations have more allowances. Please call the Information Services desk for more specific details and take advantage of this wonderful program!


SUMMER READING KICK OFF


PARENT & CHILD BOOKCLUB



ENJOY THE MUSIC OF THE NIGHT
