Subject: 2018 Fire, EMS, and Fire Marshal Incident and Response Data

The following pages represent data collected from Bucks County 9-1-1 and analyzed by our office to show activity by Fire and EMS agencies responding to emergency incidents in Warminster Township. Data for the Fire Marshal is collected locally and represents Township responses and fire inspections.

The data shown is not a full representation of the activity levels of the Fire and EMS agencies responsible for emergency response in Warminster Township.

Warminster Fire Department and Hartsville Fire Company are staffed with volunteer firefighters and no career staff. Warminster Fire Department and Hartsville Fire Company respond to multiple emergency incidents in surrounding municipalities that are **not** reflected in this report. Total activity levels of each Fire Company are collected independently and can be available upon request to the Fire Chief of each organization.


Central Bucks EMS is located on Evergreen Avenue and is contracted to provide 9-1-1 medical response within Warminster Township. Central Bucks EMS staffs one (1) medic unit with career staff 24 hours/7days a week. A second medic unit with career staff was added in February to accommodate the work load. The second medic unit with career staff operates seven days a week, 7:00am to 7:00pm.

All data presented is reflective of emergency <u>response</u> within Warminster Township and does not include training hours, special assignments, planning incidents, and administration tasks.





Fire Investigations:


- 31 Fire Investigations conducted

 - Unattended cooking







Fire Inspections:
