
## Step One: Download App


#### CloudLibrary is available in all app stores EXCEPT Kindle Fire tablets

\*Don't forget to enable "Downloads from Unknown Sources"

#### To download on the Kindle Fire tablets:

- 1. Go to Silk browser
- 2. Navigate to your cloudlibrary.com
- 3. Select Kindle Fire download option as pictured below
- 4. Follow Download Instructions on screen





### Step Two: Find Your Library

When you first open the CloudLibrary app, there will be a welcome screen. You will need to select the Language, Country, State, and Library on each screen. Choose Bucks County Free Library


# Step Three: Login Using Your Library Card

After choosing Bucks County Free Library (BCFL), login by entering your library card number and PIN number, then tap **Login Now** 



# Step Four: Search the Catalog


Once you login, you will be taken to a page with information about your library card and account. On the bottom, tap on **Search** to look at the Catalog




You can search by keywords, title, or author's name by tapping the box labeled **Enter Search Keyword(s)**. Your keyboard will appear and you can use it to type your search terms.





To view books by genre and age, tap on **All**.


Once you have found a book that you would like to check out, tap on the book's cover. Then tap **Borrow**. The item will begin to download.

NOTE: If an item displays **Hold** instead of **Borrow**, then the item is currently checked out and must be placed on hold. You can have **10** items borrowed at a time and **10** items on hold. Borrowing periods are for **two weeks**, and can be returned early. You can also flag an item if you do not want to borrow it immediately.



## Step Six: Enjoy!

After your item finishes downloading, it will automatically open and you can begin reading. Tap on **My Books** to see the books you currently have out. Physical books you have checked out will also show on this list. When you find the eBook or audiobook you would like to read, click on the **Read** button to start.



### Other Important Information

You can access your library cards and other settings by tapping the **Account** button on the bottom of the screen



Items can be returned early, however they will automatically be taken off the account after 14 days
