Since the late 19th century, library Summer Reading programs have encouraged children and families to read throughout the school break, thereby reducing the “summer slump,” in which a child can lose up to a month of reading and math comprehension. By the time a child reaches 6th grade, students can lose up to 2 grade reading levels.

Reading over the summer doesn't have to be time consuming. Spending 20 minutes a day reading newspapers, magazines, and books stops the “slump” and can even improve reading comprehension for all members of the family. Our Summer Reading Program not only encourages reading, but also exploring the world around you. Activities such as “watch the clouds and draw what you see” and “plant a seed and watch it grow” involve family members and friends in the learning process and make it fun for all ages.

Adults can take part through book reviews with each review counting as chance toward our raffle baskets. All reviews of more than one sentence are published in the library's Check It Out guide, a great resource for finding new reads. So check us out this summer for great reads and great activities!
